## Ski Swap Student Volunteer Descriptions - 2024

Here is an example of some of the student volunteer jobs available. Some positions will be customer facing and others will not be.

We are looking for students with a great personality and enjoy working with people for the customer facing positions. We have many set-up and tear-down positions that will not require any customer interactions. Sign-up for a position that match what you would be most successful at doing.

Volunteer Job	Job Description
Arrange Inventory - note different stages of swap (Friday night)	Set up ski/snowboard gear by type & size. **Will require lifting, work gloves recommended**
Arrange Inventory - Check-out (Sunday)	Consolidate remaining gear for pickup **gloves recommended**
Cashiers	Scan gear, create invoices, take credit, cash or check. Customer facing position requiring friendly personality.
Check In - Individuals	Help people check-in their gear & properly attach price tags to gear. Boots need to be tied together, skis will need to be taped. Ski & snowboard experience is helpful.
Check Out Individuals	Help customers find their unsold gear, scan gear being picked up, scan and move remaining gear.
Check In/Out Shops	Help shops carry gear in/out of trucks/gyms. **Heavy lifting, gloves recommended**
Customer Entry Queue	Manage customer (scheduled & unscheduled) entry queues. Note: Buying customers are requested to schedule an entry time via a SignupGenius form to spread out entry. May involve being outside and helping with parking.
Customer Help Desk	1) Check-in: Check tagging quality, re-attach tags as required. 2) Sale: Find and re-attach lost tags to gear and respond to customer issues. 3) Check-out: Help customers find and check-out unsold items. Previous SWAP and snow sport experience is helpful
Gear Valet Service	Assist Sellers and Buyers carry gear in/out of the swap to/from their vehicles.
Move Supplies From Storage to Gyms	Move Swap Supplies from the Storage Container by the baseball fields into the gyms.
Prepare inventory tags for used gear	Attach labels to tags, sort and organize. Wednesday after school.
Sales Assist - Gear & Clothing	Help our customers 1) find gear, 2) carry/manage gear, 3) find shop professionals for technical decisions, 4) Help with sizing decisions in poles, helmets, etc. Ski/Snowboard experience would be helpful. Must be comfortable talking to customers, require strong interpersonal skills.
Security	Secure the swap facility and inventory - monitor entry and exit points and check customer receipts
Set-up / Take-down Swap Racks, etc.	1) Move metal racks, wood and swap supplies to/from storage. **Heavy lifting, gloves recommended** 2) Setup/Take down floor covering, racks and tables, chairs. **Use power tools**
Volunteer Food Service	Arrange and serve food and beverages, keep eating area clean
